

- 1. Immediately first report is final:** Students can submit once to the assignment and a Similarity Report will be produced immediately.
- 2. Immediately (can overwrite reports until due date):** Student can submit multiple times to the assignment and receive a new Similarity Report. After 3 resubmissions, they will need to wait 24 hours after a resubmission to see a new report.
- 3. On due date:** A Similarity Report will be generated after the due date of the assignment has passed.

Instructors can select any one according to your own need. However, **Option 2** is recommended because students have chances to improve their writing if the similarity is too high.
